CYCLING EVENTS

The WNC Grand Prix 2010 bicycle races and century ride will be held the last two days in July and the first day of August.

CYCLING EVENTS:

Friday, July 30, 5:30pm – **THE OLD 70 HILL CLIMB** The 3 mile race will be on Old Hwy 70 path beginning west of Old Fort and ending at the top of the trail east of Black Mountain.

Saturday, July 31, 1:00pm – **THE LAKE TOMAHAWK CRITERIUM** The seven races around Lake Tomahawk in Black Mountain will begin with juniors and end at approximately 7:30 with the completion of the men's professional race.

Sunday, August 1, 7:30am – **THE VILLAINOUS VIPER 100** will begin and end at the Folk Art Center, near Asheville, on the Blue Ridge Parkway. The route will go north through the mountains, through downtown Burnsville, west of Hwy 26, along French Broad River, cross Merrimon Ave., climb Elk Mountain and back to the starting point. For those wanting a shorter ride, there will be the 62 mile **VIPER METRIC CENTURY**.
